Located on the first floor of the South Wing, the [Portico Rooms](#) are a spacious and versatile suite of rooms, offering a contemporary and elegant location for your ceremony.

With original features, natural daylight and uninterrupted views of the London skyline, the Portico Rooms offer a stylish and versatile backdrop.

Included in the hire are two private balconies with uninterrupted views of our famous Courtyard on one side and the River Thames on the other - providing a truly stunning setting for your special day.

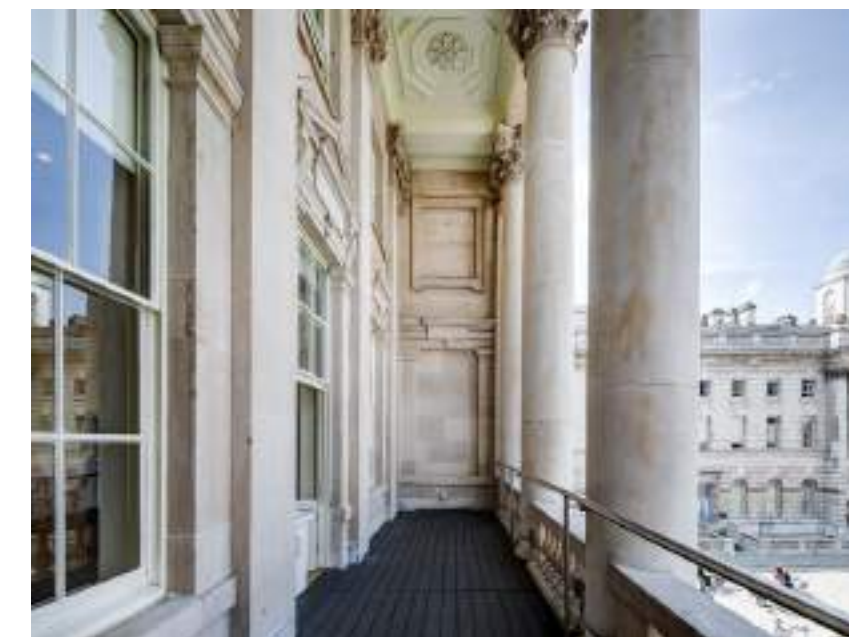
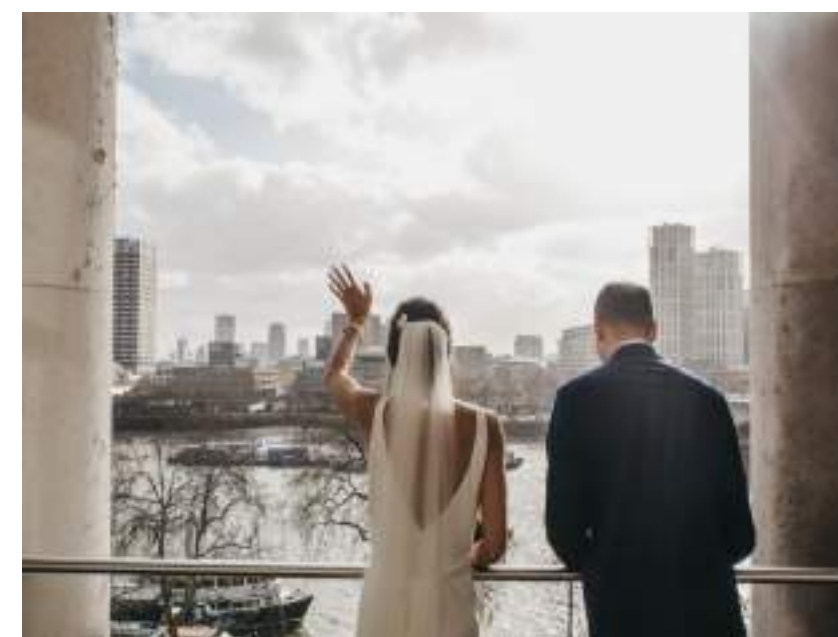

NAVY BOARD ROOMS

Steeped in history and dating back to the 18th century, the [Navy Board Rooms](#) are an impressive suite of rooms with a distinctive sense of charm and heritage.

Climbing the grand, sweeping Nelson Staircase is an experience in itself, as each flight is a one-off architectural work of art. Entering the main space, marble fireplaces and wooden floors create a grand atmosphere, with large sash windows offering panoramic views across the River Thames.

Originally home to the Navy Board, overseeing British naval affairs around the globe, the Navy Board Rooms are now a hugely popular venue. The interconnecting rooms offer wonderful natural light, original features and great flexibility.

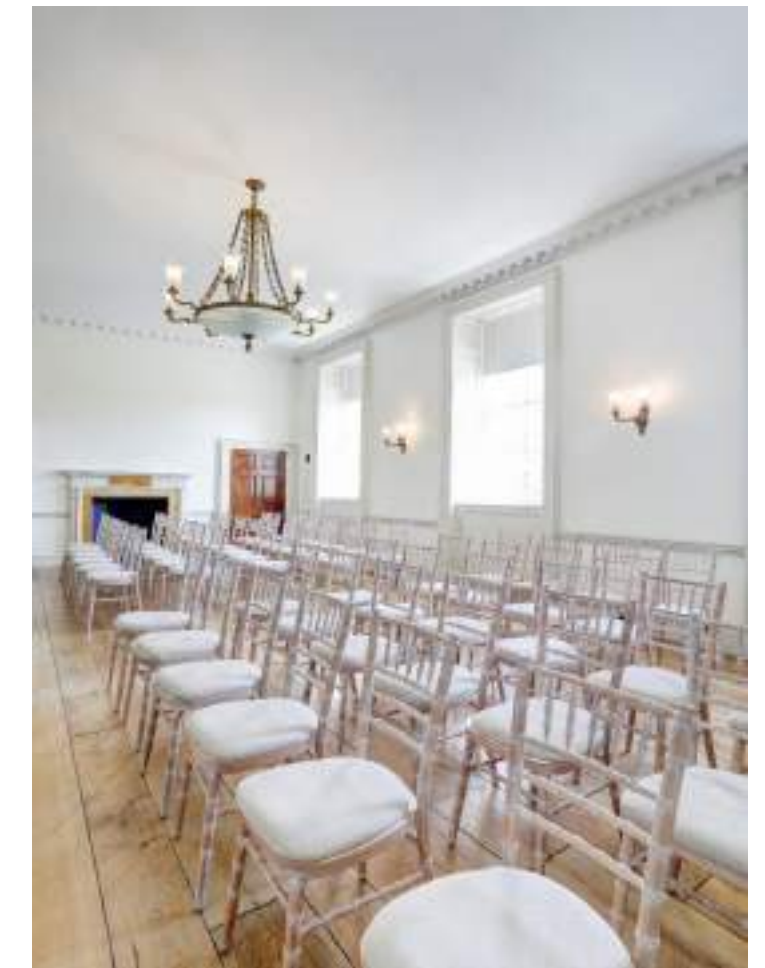

Please note that as an arts and culture centre open to the public, we cannot confirm what might be happening in the Courtyard - or around the rest of the public areas - at Somerset House at any time. We have a very exciting and constantly expanding cultural programme, which sees a variety of installations, exhibitions, artwork and public events across the site. It's a huge part of what makes us Somerset House. There are also occasions where essential works need to take place on the building and these instances are out of our control.

HIRE DETAILS



Please note that wedding ceremony offers are available at weekends only. Capacities are also subject to the guidelines and social distancing requirements in place at the time of your event.

Licensing:

Both the Portico Rooms and Navy Board Rooms are licensed for civil ceremonies. A registrar is an additional fee and must be booked directly via the [City of Westminster](#). Costs start from £701.

Venue Hire Fee:

Included within this fee is an Event Manager, pre and post event cleaning, up to 100 chairs for the ceremony event set-up and 2 clothed tables.

Accredited Suppliers:

Catering, AV, production and all other requirements, including furniture, are in addition to the venue quote. Please note that you are required to use Somerset House's accredited suppliers only, for all aspects of your event. You can view our list [here](#). If you would like us to gather some initial quotes on your behalf then please do let us know.

Refundable Security Deposit:

A refundable security deposit of £1,500 is required for all bookings. This will be invoiced separately to the Hire Fee. This deposit is fully refundable up to 30 days after the event, subject to no damage having been caused to the building or overrunning of the contracted timings.

Public Liability Insurance:

Somerset House require all clients to have £10 million public liability insurance.

COVID-19:

We are following the official Working Safely during Covid-19 Government guidance to make sure the whole building is Covid secure for all staff and visitors. This is an ongoing process and will be updated as government advice changes. All guests are required to follow Somerset House's [guidelines](#)

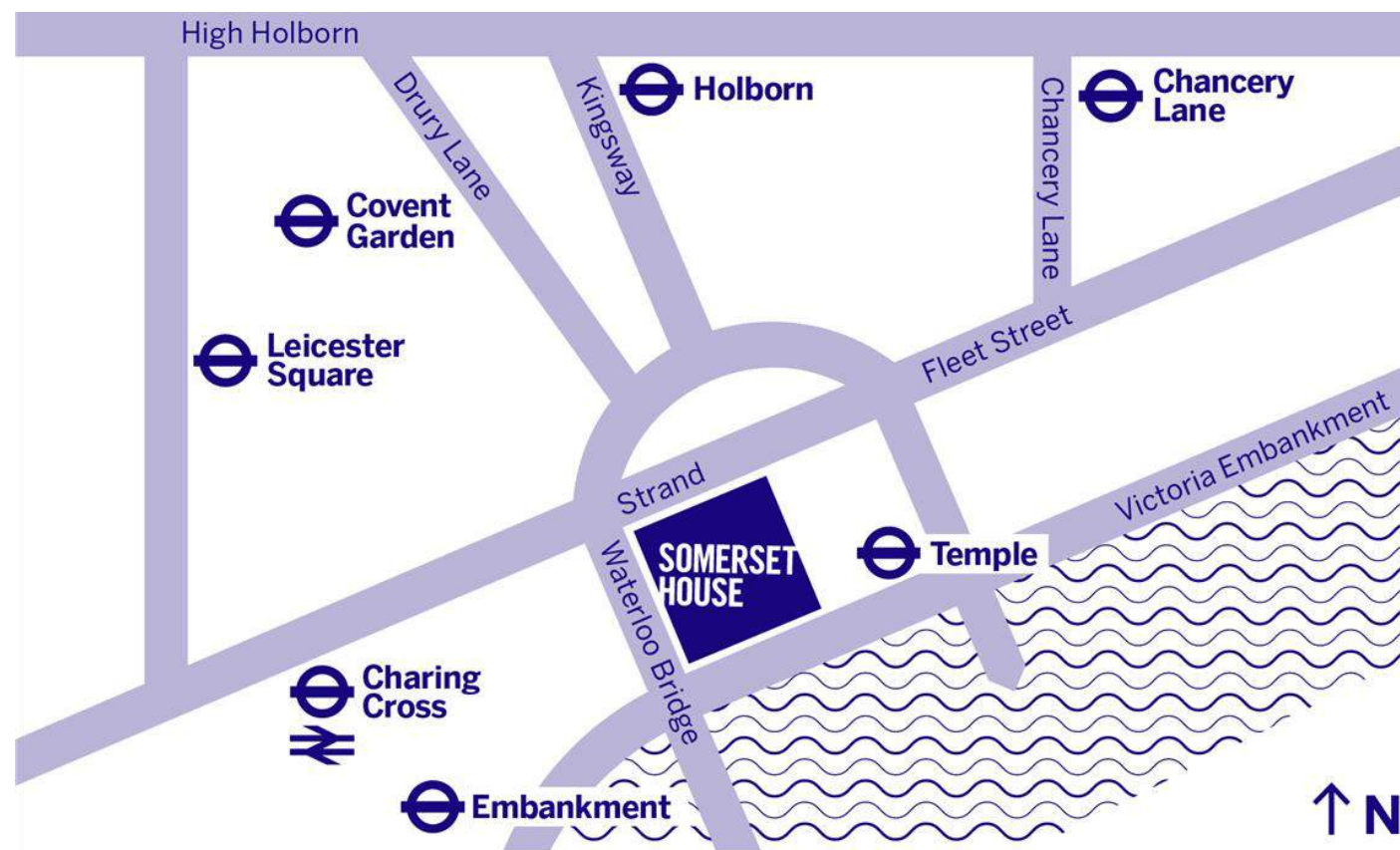
